Key vocabulary	Definition
Perspective	The way that objects appear smaller when they are further away and the way parallel lines appear to meet each other at a point in the distance.
One point	Use of a formula to produce the appearance of depth all points diverging in one place.
Two point	Use of a formula to produce the appearance of depth all points diverging in parts of the picture plane.
Depth	The appearance of space within the flat picture plane.
Distance	A point on the horizon.
Space	The appearance of depth with in the picture plane.
Grounds fore/ mid/back	How to differentiate space within a picture plane near. mid and background elements big/mid-size/small.
Atmospheric perspective	The appearance of space by making the mid to background elements of a picture less distinct and more pastel in appearance.
Vanishing point	The point on the picture plane where all things converge.
Parallel line	A <u>line</u> that is always at the same distance from another line.
Critical Study	Referencing and looking at is some detail the work and experience of aa artist or artists in order to gain some understanding and direction in one's own work.
