Critical Study	Referencing and looking at in some detail the work and experience of an artist or artists in order to gain some understanding and direction in one's own work.
Analyse	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To examine in detail in order to discover meaning, essential features, etc. 2. To break down into components or essential features. to analyse a financial structure.
Context	Context means the setting of a word or event.
Graphic Project	Graphic design is the practice of composing and arranging the visual elements of a project. Designing the layout of a magazine, creating a poster for a theatre performance, and designing packaging for a product are all examples of graphic design.
Illustration	Anything from a drawing of a comic book character to a diagram of the digestive system in a biology textbook can be an illustration. The point is to visually represent something — be it a concept, a character, a story, or a message. As technology has evolved, so have our methods for creating illustrations.
Sculpture	sculpture, an artistic form in which hard or plastic materials are worked into three-dimensional art objects. The designs may be embodied in freestanding objects, in reliefs on surfaces, or in environments ranging from tableaux to contexts that envelop the spectator; depth/space/shape/form/surface.
