Key Vocabulary	Definition
Paint	A fluid containing pigment of various hues
Scale	Size / large or small...medium
Pattern	Repetitive shape or form rhythmically reproduced to form a recognisable beat
Line	An element of art defined by a point moving in space.
Value	The lightness or darkness of tones or colours. White is the lightest value; black is the darkest. The value halfway between these extremes is called middle grey.
Texture	An element of art that refers to the way things feel, or look as if they might feel if touched.
Shape	An element of art that is two-dimensional, flat, or limited to height and width.
Pigment / colour	The actual colour value of the paint . a scientific explanation is refraction of light waves of different types from surface to eye receptors / actual
Primary colour	Red , Yellow, Blue..... cannot be made
Secondary colour	Two primary colours mixed can be made
Hue	Colour actual
Value	The light and dark effect of the colour on the eye
