<b>Life Drawing</b>	Drawing the figure in a pose.
<b>Mixed Media</b>	Different methods for producing art.
<b>Portraiture</b>	The act or art of making portraits.
<b>Illustration</b>	A picture in a book, magazine, etc. or the process of illustrating something.
<b>Sculpture</b>	The art of forming solid objects that represent a thing, person, idea, etc. out of a material such as wood, clay, metal, or stone, or an object made in this way.
<b>Drawing</b>	The act of making a picture with a pencil or pen, or a picture made in this way: Graphic, line.
<b>Mixed Media</b>	Using more than one different material or discipline in a piece of work i.e. painting and sculpture.
<b>Emulation</b>	The process of copying something achieved by someone else and trying to do it as well as they have.
<b>Own Style</b>	The qualities that make a person or thing different from others.
<b>Quality</b>	How good or bad something is.
<b>Refine</b>	To make something pure or improve something, especially by removing unwanted material.
<b>Critical Study</b>	Referencing and looking at in some detail the work and experience of an artist or artists in order to gain some understanding and direction in one's own work.
