<b>Lino Print/Cut</b>	A linocut is a relief print produced in a manner similar to a woodcut but that uses linoleum as the surface into which the design is cut and printed from.
<b>Clay</b>	Clay is a type of soil or dirt that's made of very small particles. You can mould clay into different shapes when it's wet. Clay is terrible for planting a vegetable garden, but it's perfect for making pottery, tiles, or bricks.
<b>Composition</b>	Composition is another word for writing — the act of writing or the piece of writing that results. It also refers to what something is made of. The word composition comes from the Latin componere, meaning "put together" and its meaning remains close to this.
<b>Mono Print</b>	The monoprint is a form of printmaking where the image can only be made once, unlike most printmaking which allows for multiple originals.
<b>Critical Study</b>	Referencing and looking at is some detail the work and experience of aa artist or artists in order to gain some understanding and direction in one's own work.
