Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Voice</b>	A particular opinion or attitude expressed.
<b>Culture</b>	The ideas, customs and social behaviour of a particular people or society.
<b>Context</b>	The circumstances around a text that can help it be fully understood.
<b>Tradition</b>	The passing on of customs or beliefs from generation to generation.
<b>Iambic pentameter</b>	A line of verse with five pairs of syllables.
<b>Imagery</b>	Descriptive writing that appeals to one or more of the five senses.
<b>Persona</b>	A character in a poem.
<b>Form</b>	How we describe the structure or pattern of a poem.
<b>Irony</b>	Something that seems the deliberate opposite of what is expected or meant.
<b>Stanza</b>	An arrangement of lines of poetry into one block.
<b>Semantic field</b>	A set of words that are related through meaning.
<b>Unseen</b>	Not previously read or prepared.
<b>Inspirational</b>	Making you feel full of hope or encouragement.
<b>Rhythm</b>	The measured flow of words or phrases.
