Key Vocabulary	Definition
<b>Round</b>	Making a number simpler but keeping its value close to what it was.
<b>Significant Figure</b>	The number of digits that are meaningful.
<b>Power</b>	How many times to use the number in a multiplication.
<b>Integer</b>	Whole number
<b>Decimal Place</b>	The position of a digit in the place value system to the right of the decimal point.
<b>Overestimate</b>	An estimate that is greater than the actual answer.
<b>Underestimate</b>	An estimate that is less than the actual answer.
<b>Square Root</b>	Value of a number that, when multiplied by itself, gives the number.
<b>Operation</b>	The effect on a number such as addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. There are many others.
<b>Order</b>	The rule which states which operation comes first.
<b>Deposit</b>	The initial payment made when buying something.
<b>Interest</b>	The money paid for using other money. Example, money paid when borrowing a sum of money.
<b>Credit</b>	The trust that lets people give things (like goods, services or money) to others, in the hope they will repay it a later agreed date.
<b>Debit</b>	An account entry showing a reduction in what you (or a business) are worth.
<b>Balance</b>	The sum of money in an account

The system of measuring based on meter for length, kilogram for mass and second for time.
