| Linear | A straight-line relationship |
| Variable | A symbol for a value we don't know yet. |
| Convert | To change |
| Approximation | A result that is not exact, but close enough to be used. |
| Exchange Rate | The value of one currency in terms of the value of another currency. |
| Currency | Money, such as coins or banknotes. |
| Estimate | To find a value that is close enough to the right answer, usually with some thought or calculation involved. |
| Orientation | Someone or something relative to the points of a compass or other specified position |
| Similar | When one shape can become another after a resize, flip, slide or turn. |
| Corresponding | A close similarity or connection between two variables. |
| Enlargement | To change size of something by a given scale factor. |
| Scale Factor | A quantity by which you enlarge something. |
