## **Mobile Phone Policy Moving Forward**

We worked with the University of the West of England in reflecting on the views of students, staff, parents and carers as stakeholders and their <u>published report</u> gave us some reflection and certainly any change in strategy would want to address the areas raised here. Gordano School in Portishead, which is part the Lighthouse Schools Partnership, has already introduced Yondr pouches (<u>How It Works — Yondr</u>) and we recently took student members of the School Forum along with some staff and governors to Gordano School to talk to them about the implementation of these. We will continue to work with the students involved on this project. I know other local schools are looking at similar strategies too.

### **Challenge Partners Visit**

A Challenge Partners team of five reviewers visited us last week from Wednesday to Friday. The written feedback we received talked about our 'climate for learning' being excellent and our curriculum enrichment provision which helps develop the whole child being really extensive. Again the review team were really impressed with their interaction with the students in particular and the opportunities and support that students receive.
