**Year 7 Parent/Carer Information Evening (Online and In Person)
Monday 23rd May at 7pm**

We are really pleased with how Year 7 have settled in with us over the past months and I know many of you will have taken up the opportunity to make appointments with specific subject staff for the Year 7 Parents' Evening on Wednesday 11th May.

I am writing to let you know we are running an Information Evening on Monday 23rd May starting at 7pm, online and in person, for all Year 7 parents and carers, where we are going to talk through the arrangements for our Enrichment Week which takes place between Monday 20th and Friday 24th June along with details around the Year 7 Assessment Week which takes place between Monday 13th and Friday 17th June. We are anticipating this will take about 20 minutes and we will be happy to take any questions at the end.

It is important with regards to the Assessment Week that students use this as part of their learning, getting used to sitting some 'exam style' questions in class amongst other activities as part of their preparation for examinations at the end of Year 11 and some preparation may be required. At the same time, it is important that these do not create anxiety amongst our young people and the evening will help parents and carers understand our process so that we can together support the young people through this at an appropriate level.
