Online Learning – Friday 18th February

Thank you for your patience whilst we hastily look to move onto online learning for tomorrow. Can I firstly reiterate that the decision to close the school was taken on health and safety grounds by our local authority, Bath and North East Somerset.

We will endeavour to deliver our lessons online at this short notice; however if we had supply staff or in particular lessons staff are absent then this might not be possible. I have asked staff to engage with students for at least part of the hour lesson time. I am also conscious that many of our staff will have their own children at home whilst this is happening.

All of our lessons tomorrow will be on Microsoft Teams. The lessons will run as per the last lockdown as detailed below:

- There will be no tutor period.
- Periods 1-5 will run at normal times.
- Where possible, teachers will be on Teams at the start of the lesson and will direct accordingly.
- Where teachers are unavailable we will endeavour to set an appropriate task on the class Team but please note this may not be available for every lesson.
