After enduring cruelty at the hands of her aunt and at the orphanage, Jane finds work as a governess where she meets, and falls for, the darkly brooding Mr Rochester. As her feeling develop she uncovers a terrible secret.



As he twists the key and slowly creeps into the grand mansion left to him in his father's will, Salem Brownstone has an eerie feeling that his world is about to change. Aside from the money and the house, his father's secret legacy includes an unfinished battle with a creature from another world. He needs help to avoid the tragic fate of his father.






