Planning for: Expert subject delivery

- Informed by curriculum and specification
- Well-sequenced learning that builds on knowledge
 - Taught to the top, scaffolded for all to achieve
 - Increasing complexity over time
- Key vocabulary is accessible and used purposefully

Retrieval start to every lesson



- Time-limited
- Quiet and focused, embedded in routine
- Completed independently

- Based on previous content
- Pitched appropriately
- Answers reviewed

Routines and expectations

- Effective teacher modelling at every opportunity
- Seating plan as standard
- Correct equipment on desk
- Pride demonstrated in learners' work



Developing thinking

- Lesson tasks appropriate for learners
- · All learners engaged in thinking
- All learners ready to make verbal contributions
- Wait-time is built into questioning

Capturing evidence of learning

- Sufficient time is given for application of learning, recorded in the most appropriate way
- Students' writing is strengthened at every opportunity
- Written and verbal clarity is a constant focus
- Subject-specific terminology taught throughout

Purposeful checking for understanding

- Assessment to identify learning, feedback to improve learning
- Cold-calling questioning featured in every lesson
- · Other techniques used across the sequence of learning
