Extra-Curricular Clubs – Autumn 2020

We are delighted to announce that our extra-curricular programme will begin again next week from 12th October for PE clubs and 19th October for Performing Arts clubs. Whilst it isn't our usual expansive offer as we are restricted by both the limitations of year group bubbles and also by other after school commitments, we hope that many students will take the opportunity to take part.

The following clubs are on offer after school from 3:15pm to 4:15pm each day. At Christmas we will re-evaluate the participation and any further advice from the Government, the DCMS, Sporting Governing Bodies and Arts Council to decide on our offer for January. It is vital that anyone attending these clubs follows the instructions given to ensure that we know who is attending and to keep everyone safe.

- Participants for each club will meet at the end of the school day in the specified classroom on the table attached and wait, sat in a chair, for their member of staff to arrive. Please note that staff will not always be there immediately if they are teaching a group that is dismissed after the year group club they are taking, so participants must be able to wait patiently and calmly.
- They will be taken to their club area by the teacher leading their club. If it is dry they will take their bags with them, if wet they will be able to leave them in the designated classroom.
- No changing facilities are available so they must come suitably dressed or with the equipment to be ready to participate. All football will be on grass so studs are essential.
- Students must have permission to stay after school so parents/carers need to sign their child's diary, giving them permission to attend the club. This will also allow staff to know that there is a legitimate reason for the student to wear their PE kit to school on a non PE day.
- At the end of a session parents/carers can pick their child up from the car park within the school fence if their activity is on the top field or Performing Arts based and from the Sports Hall car park if the activity is on the astro field, astroturf, gym, tennis courts or Sports Hall.
- Cheerleading has a fee as it is run by a qualified instructor. Payments for Cheerleading must be made via ParentPay and an additional letter is attached for this. The timing of this activity is slightly different and will run from 3:15pm – 4:45pm
- We will be running a tennis club in the future through Bishop Sutton Tennis Club. We will send further details when this club is available.

As and when any other clubs are able to be offered we will promote them via the portal, email and on the school twitter account.

Extra-curricular is a huge part of what students enjoy at Chew Valley so we really hope that many students will take up this offer.

Cheerleading

We are excited to be able to tell you that we are able to re-start our cheerleading programme. It will initially take on a different format to that which our cheerleaders have been used to but we are closely following Sport Cheer England's Return to Play guidance in order to keep all our participants and our coach safe.

Sessions will currently have to remain in year group bubbles for the moment so we have planned to work on a two week rota as shown below. This means that there will be five sessions for each year group prior to Christmas. We will continue to monitor changes in Government advice and adjust accordingly where we can. Sessions run from 3:15pm until 4:45pm when you will need to arrange for your child to be picked up from the car park at the leisure centre end of the school.

Sessions will be able to include conditioning, dance and unsupported tumbles but stunting is not allowed at this stage. We really hope that returning and new cheerleaders will take up this opportunity as we know, from them telling us, how much they have missed their sport.

As this activity has an external instructor there is a cost for the sessions. The five session term has a cost of £30, (this works out at £6 per session for 90 minutes). Fees must be paid via ParentPay. If you would like your child to take part in these five sessions, please send an email to enquiries@chewvalleyschool.co.uk, stating your child's name, tutor group and 'cheerleading' in the message so that the payment can be added to your ParentPay account. Payment can be made online, via 'ParentPay', by logging into the school website, www.chewvalleyschool.co.uk. Click on 'Parents' from the toolbar and select 'ParentPay' which will take you to the ParentPay website.

The first session will be on Tuesday 6th October for Year 9 as this is Week B.

We will obviously keep you updated with any changes that occur and also if competitions, virtual or otherwise, are likely to happen.
